Bostonians are very proud of their city. Let the staff at Corinthian Events whisk you around Boston to show you many of Boston's unique and innovative off-site venues. Each site offers something different for your attendees.

The JFK Library and Museum is a memorial to John F. Kennedy, the 35th President of the United States. The Library can accommodate groups from 10 to 1000 and has breathtaking views of the Boston Harbor. From the Library, you will drive along Boston's waterfront past a wide variety of scenic waterfront venues including the Bank of America Pavilion, Institute of Contemporary Art, John Joseph Moakley U.S. Courthouse, Boston Children's Museum, Tea Party Ships and Museum and the New England Aquarium. You will then visit the State Room located on the 33rd floor of Sixty State Street with panoramic views of Boston. The State Room offers a selection of rooms accommodating groups to 900. Upon your return you will pass the Old State House. The Old State House is a historic building built in 1713 and was the seat of the Massachusetts legislature until 1798. It is the oldest surviving public building in Boston and can accommodate groups. The new Massachusetts State House and current capital of the Commonwealth sits on Beacon Hill and is open for private events
