Worcester, located in central Massachusetts, has a population of 182,500 with more than six million people living within a 50-mile radius. The second-largest city in New England, Worcester is less than an hour west of Boston and north of Providence, RI. A five-time recipient of the All-America City Award, Worcester combines the historic charm of a small town with the convenience of a thriving metropolitan city. Our central location to Massachusetts and all of New England makes Worcester an ideal location for meetings and events.

Our largest venue, the newly renovated DCU Arena and Convention Center, consists of exhibition halls, ballrooms, meeting rooms and a 14,800 seat arena. The downtown state of the art convention facility with more than 135,000 square feet of space was fully integrated with the existing arena in 1997.

Depending on the event requirements, we have a number of potential locations for events. A few examples are our seven hotels, the DCU Convention Center / Arena, the Hanover Theatre for the Performing Arts, Mechanics Hall, Tuckerman Hall, Union Station or one of our City's colleges or universities.
